Our 2024-2027 strategy outlines three key priorities towards this goal: **advocating**, **mobilising**, and **supporting**.

It is clear to us that major change is needed to make the UK's asylum system fair and compassionate. Building on our existing strong relationships, and with an expanded advocacy team, we will bring our Jewish values-led vision for a fairer, more welcoming asylum system to policy makers and the media.

But while we know change is urgently needed, we also understand that it will not happen overnight.

We will therefore also directly support, running transformative projects to help displaced people overcome challenges, integrate, and rebuild their lives.



Bringing this work together, we will mobilise the Jewish community, driving engagement with our core issues and building a cross-communal movement for change.

With our new Community Engagement Director, we are educating, facilitating volunteering opportunities and encouraging activism. This includes through our Student Refugee Ambassador Programme and Synagogues of Sanctuary scheme.

As a HIAS+JCORE major donor, you will play a key part in advancing our goals – and can develop a deeper and closer relationship with our work.

Together, with your support, we will strive toward our vision of a world where refugees find safety, community, and are welcomed by good neighbours.



Why we need your support

We have ambitious plans for 2026.

We've introduced exciting new community engagement programmes, including our Synagogue of Sanctuary and Student Refugee Ambassador Programme schemes, and have expanded our lifechanging JUMP befriending project to Brighton and Hove.

With the far-right on the rise, and UK riots still in recent memory, we will also be developing our social cohesion and interfaith work.

Crucially, this will include developing our Interfaith Refugee Network, bringing together faith leaders to advocate for a more compassionate refugee policy.

As an organisation led by Jewish values and experience, but one proud to look outward and partner within, and outside, the Jewish community, we are uniquely placed to deliver this work.

But we can only achieve these goals with your support.

These plans require our team to grow – and with your help, we will expand our capacity to put our Advocacy and Community Engagement strategies into practice.



What becoming a giving community donor helps us achieve – our impact

By joining our giving community, you ensure that we can make a significant and lasting difference to the lives of the people we support.

Every day, we see the impact that our work makes – and by becoming a major donor, you become part of this.

From helping secure policy change to empowering refugees to overcome barriers, here's what we achieved last year.

In 2025, we:

- Worked with 94 asylum seeking and refugee young people and befrienders on our JUMP project.
- Brought our message to over 2,000 people across the UK.
- Met 27 MPs, members of the House of Lords and local councillors, ensuring our advocacy goals were heard.



Giving community benefits
